Scoring is done on the following scale: +4 +2 0 -2 -4

For the following questions, SA = +4, A = +2, N = 0, D = -2, SD = -4

For the following questions, SA = -4, A = -2, N = 0, D = +2, SD = +4

A score of +160 would indicate extreme conservatism and a score of -160 would be extreme liberalism. Score can thus be grouped on a bell curve around a midline of 0.
